

HYDE PARK DEVELOPMENT REVIEW BOARD  
MEETING MINUTES October 6, 2009

A site walk and periodic permit review was held at the Green River State Park at 5:30 PM. Park staff explained that they now have 12 composting toilets, six of which are new. They are considering replacing portolets at the parking area with composting toilets if federal grant funding becomes available. As of September 6, 2009 the Park had 10,758 visitors. The ADA ramp has been completed and a dedication ceremony has been held. Shoreline retention measures have been completed. A new information kiosk will be installed after Columbus Day weekend. The old kiosk is being donated to the Zack Woods Pond parking area. Solar panels have been designed (for Park power) at thirty-nine feet tall. The solar power project bid process will occur during this fall and winter with construction slated for next season.

The DRB returned to the Hyde Park Elementary School for a warned hearing on the record. GG explained the necessity of signing in for participants who wanted to establish interested party status.

Parks Regional Manager Susan Bulmer reiterated the above information on the record at the hearing.

GG recessed the hearing on Application #2009-11, Levin, to November 3, 2009 at 7:00 PM as no one was present to represent the project.

GG recessed the hearing on Application #2009-01, Hight & Alfieri, to November 3, 2009 at 7:05 PM at the telephone request of Consultant Roy Marble.

GG recessed the hearing on Application #2009-44, Sterling Meadows Farm, LLC to November 3, 2009 at 7:10 PM as no one was present to represent the project.

A motion was made and seconded to adjourn at 7:30 PM.
