Picked up some lactose and sugar free, but we didn't get the word to servers.  
Table managers need to be early to know where supplies are; know what ice cream is there.

Another ice tray?? One or two tables?? To help speed up serving.  
Toppings were fabulous – strawberries were bought earlier, cut up frozen, 5 qts  
Whipped cream cans 4 cans recommended  
Scoopers should make scoops ahead of time to be prepared for people as they come.  
Ice cream sticks to some scoops. Use scoops with scrapers.  
Take 5 gal hot water (ran out this year)  
Four 5 lb bags worked for 1 tray – need 8 bags for 2 trays
