## LCDS Budget Committee Questions - LCSD Answers

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- 1.) *Please provide line item details for your FY2014 budget projection, and how that relates to specific hours of community policing. From the Committee's perspective there are some aspects of police services that we feel are important and want to see greater focus on, such as an increase in foot patrols in lieu of or in addition to vehicle patrols (a presence on the street), an increase in speed limit enforcement in key areas (downtowns and village streets). Based on those priorities, what could we expect in terms of number of hours per week, or month if that is easier, to these activities under your proposed FY2014 budget and without any staffing increases?*

**We cannot put a number of hours per week or per month for foot patrols and/or speed enforcements. As the deputies time varies with the number of complaints they receive per shift. As of right now we only have one person per shift during the daytime. That deputy cannot be expected to be conducting a foot patrol in Johnson Village and then have to respond to Wolcott when he would have to run back to his vehicle. As the hours per town indicates, for the last few years, the LCSD is working roughly the hours paid for by each community. When work load allows, we conduct foot patrols and traffic enforcements. - 2.) *How could you adjust your operations to greater meet community needs and priorities identified above if it is determined that we cannot not afford an increase in the patrol budget?*

**We are already using qualified part-timers for foot patrols. They are not always available and for the last several years we have been over budget, so this is not sustainable. LCSD priorities have always been to respond to calls for service first.**

- 3.) *What is the projected increase to the patrol budget, if one full-time detective position was funded by the "patrol towns"? Would this require the addition of a patrol car?*

**Please refer to Attachment 2 to see the projected increase to the patrol budget if a full-time detective were to be added.**

**Yes, this would require the addition of a patrol car, but for the initial vehicle purchase LCSD would buy the vehicle through other means before putting the cost on the taxpayers. This vehicle should last 4 to 5 years.**

4.) *If a second position, such as a code enforcement officer, was funded by the towns, how could that position's hours be spread between the towns? Johnson and Hyde Park are interested in this concept, but Wolcott would most likely not be billed for the increased services.*

**The cost for that position would be split by the percentage each town pays towards the entire budget, or by percentage of use.**

5.) *Can you provide trends or statistics in criminal activity from the monthly reports, to show a three year average or three year history to show how patrol funds are being expended? For example, can you show if there has been an increase in drug related crimes, or crimes against the elderly and that those increases have reduced your ability to provide other services? How would hiring a full time detective reduce those crimes, speed up convictions and reduce overtime costs?*

**Statistics seem to be indicating that our communities consistently deal with quality of life issues. I think that having crimes solved helps reassure people. By hiring a detective, convictions may not only be sped up, but people may be more assured of a conviction and by the fact that their cases are being worked on.**

6.) *Will the addition of a detective position allow patrol officers to perform foot patrols, speed enforcement patrols and other community priorities – for example, 10 hour a week dedicated to the above and shared by participating towns?*

**If follow up is completed by a detective and a patrol deputy has more time freed up, they should be conducting more patrol related activities, this isn't guaranteed but would probably be the case.**

7.) *How are expenditures for patrol services kept separate from expenses from your other services (court, fees for service, etc.)? It seems that it would be a very sophisticated system to track all expenses and then off-set them from the fees paid by the towns, especially, if Wolcott does not fund the code enforcement position.*

8.) *If you have a deputy vacancy, where are the salary revenues (the towns' patrol fees) applied?*
