Update on the Concession Stand~the roof is on! The Carpenters are working on the inside walls, putting milk house panels on.

Larry Jourdan is working on the power. He has been asking some of his suppliers for material donations with some success.

Jamie Dubie is going to check with GMCR about a Keurig machine and K cups.

Ken donated the lumber for the building siding, which Everett Demeritt ship lapped. He advised they will not be able to use some of it and will need to get some from Heath Lumber.

Gary proposed that the fields need new fences, ground sockets, plugs, etc that will cost around \$2,437.16 (includes shipping), and Men's league would pay \$1437.16, wants the Rec to pay \$ 1000.00. Ken made the motion to pay the \$1000.00 in conjunction with the Men's league, Motion carried with all in favor.

The Rec Committee voted to buy the new bases and home plates from Green Mountain Sports who donated the first set which lasted 8 years.

Aaron McGee and Chris Brown came to the meeting, which the Committee was very pleased! They are going to coach the soccer kids, their games go from September 8<sup>th</sup> to October 20<sup>th</sup>. They are going to charge between \$20.00 and \$35.00 registration fee, they will need the fields on Saturday morning and the practice week-days. They are considering to help pay for the mowing of the fields. Having representation for the youth league will be very helpful. The Members asked Aaron and Kris if they would be interested in being on the Rec Committee.

Brad McKnight will be doing the Mackenzie Pratt tournament on September 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup>. Not sure when or if Keith Mailhotte is doing the kick-ball tournament.

Members from the Rec Committee should go to the Select board Meeting on June 7<sup>th</sup>, they are discussing "No drinking" on Town property which would include the fields.
