



Reflective 911 House Numbering Sign Order Form

There are many websites that can supply you with the required 4" reflective sign; however, residents may also choose to request signs through the town office at town cost. To order through the town, please fill out the below information, attach the fee and return to the Town Clerk's Office (night drop box, PO Box 98, Hyde Park, VT 05655 or hand deliver). We will contact you when the sign is ready.

One double-side reflective sign (green backing plate with white #'s)

Please check box if you would like assistance installing the sign. Additional charge to cover cost of post may apply. No labor charge.

Sign Installation instructions:

Both sides of the sign should be visible from either traffic lane and be installed near the intersection of your driveway and the road. The bottom of the sign should be at least 36" above the ground, see below recommended installations. Signs too low are more easily blocked by vegetation and snow.

A reduction of only a minute in the response time for fire, ambulance or rescue units substantially reduces the death rate in heart attack, injury accident and other life and death emergencies. It also reduces the chances of a total loss in a structure fire.

Your local emergency professionals, and the mutual aid responders from nearby towns, know the importance of quick response times. The national emergency 9-1-1 system was developed to improve the effectiveness of our emergency responders.



However, most delays by emergency responders occur because the responders can not find the scene. They know the address, but can't find it because many times the resident or business has not properly displayed their address number so it is easily visible as they approach the location.

The new 2012 Hyde Park 911 Street Naming and Numbering Ordinance requires all locations to have a registered 911 address and to display the number of the location on reflective signs. Residents must use 4" high reflective numbers on a contrasting reflective color background. The old ordinance required three inch numbers and those signs DO NOT need to be replaced until necessary. However, if replaced due to damage or other reason, then the 4" high number must be installed.



Hyde Park Fire & EMS are starting a new public awareness program in 2013. Residents that need signs or would like to upgrade to the new 4" high numbers are encouraged to do so. The Fire & EMS volunteers are available to help. Please contact any member of your fire or EMS professionals if you have any questions about the proper location for a sign.



Improper addressing and signage may frustrate emergency responders, but it could be deadly to the resident in need. Please install the proper sign and ensure that it is visible to responders throughout the year.
