



VILLAGE OF HYDE PARK, VERMONT

WARNING FOR THE ANNUAL VILLAGE MEETING
TUESDAY, MAY 2, 2017

The annual meeting of the Incorporated Village of Hyde Park, Vermont is hereby called and legal voters therein are warned to meet at the Hyde Park Elementary School Library on the first Tuesday in May, 2017 at 7:00 PM for the transaction of the following business, viz:

- Article 1. To elect a President for the ensuing year.
- Article 2. To adopt rules of order for the transaction of business.
- Article 3. Consideration and approval of the summarization of minutes of the 2016 Annual Meeting.
- Article 4. To elect a Trustee of the Bliss Library Fund for a term of three years, term held by Gary Anderson expires.
- Article 5. To elect a Village Trustee for a term of two (2) years, term held by Frederika French expires.
- Article 6. To elect a Village Trustee for a term of three (3) years, term held by Peter Gallo expires.
- Article 7. To hear, act upon and accept the report of the Village Officers.
- Article 8. To determine if the Village voters will approve the estimated budget as proposed by the Board of Trustees for 2017, authorize the estimated General Department expenditure of \$64,883, of which \$35,003 is to be raised by taxes at the rate of .082%, an increase from the current rate of .080%, which is expected to generate increase of \$854 to be used for operations of the General Department.
- Article 9. To determine if the Village voters will authorize the Trustees to borrow money on promissory notes of the Village and to defray current expenses of the Village.
- Article 10. To set a due date of August 31, 2017 for Village Taxes and an interest percentage of 1 percent (1%) for the first three months and thereafter, one and one half percent (1 ½%) and an eight percent (8%) penalty for delinquent taxes.
- Article 11. To see if the Village voters will agree to indemnify and hold all elected and appointed officials harmless from and against all liability claims and suits of any type brought against them as a consequence of their service, except those caused by and arising out of their intentional or willful misconduct, said indemnity to include all damages, costs and attorney fees.
- Article 12. Shall the Village voters authorize reversal of the permanent transfer of \$20,000 from the Water Department to the General Department fund for the construction of sidewalks, therefore allowing use of the \$20,000 for the operations of the Water Department.
- Article 13. To act upon any other business that may legally be brought before said meeting.
