NOTICE - OPEN TERMS FOR ELECTIVE OFFICE

The deadline for petitions seeking to have your name on the Town Meeting ballot for elected office is Monday, January 29, 2018 at 5:00 p.m. to the Town Clerk's Office.

You must be 18 years old and a registered Hyde Park voter. Petition forms are available at the town clerk's office and require 22 signatures from residents that are also on the voter checklist. New terms start immediately after town meeting:

Selectboard – 2 year term

Selectboard – 3 year term

Town Lister – 3 year term

Lamoille North Modified Unified Union School District Director - 3 year term
