

Minutes of the Hyde Park Energy Committee  
March 14, 2018

Previous meeting minutes were accepted and the meeting commenced.  
In attendance: Jay Hersh, Marilyn Zophar and Denise Greene, (Carol Roberts was available for questions before the meeting began)

The date for showing the movie *An Inconvenient Sequel* was set for April 19 or 20, 2018. It was agreed that a potluck dessert would be advertised and we would serve desserts before the movie begins. It was suggested by MZ that we hold the movie earlier for older residents and that it was school vacation week, so younger families might be away for vacation. The time was agreed upon as 7pm. Since Earth Day falls shortly after the event, it would be themed an Earth Day event in the publicity. It was suggested by MZ that we have a facilitator at the end of the movie to conduct the discussion. She suggested Efficiency Vermont. No tasks were outlined or assigned. JH has done some preliminary work with the Library and will see if either dates are available and once scheduled will notify the newspaper of the event.

The meeting with the Craftsbury Energy Committee (CES) was the next item to be discussed and it was suggested by DG that we come up with a list of project ideas from our notes taken at the meeting. MZ agreed with this and the lists will be shared in an email message. MZ also agreed it will be helpful with our plan for upcoming projects to have ideas on paper.

It was brought up by JH. that the suggestion by DG to put energy saving tips on Front Porch Forum would be a great way to move that project forward. JH further lamented that there was no way to use graphics on FPF but it would still work well. DG has 10-12 tips and will post one tip per month. DG will email the tip to members with the date it will be posted.

Our last agenda item, a plan of our projects and calendar for 2018 was tabled until we have more time to discuss and plan at our next meeting in April.
