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10 Susan opened the meeting at 8:40 a.m.

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12 1. **Welcome & Agenda Review & Public Comment** ~ No public present; No agenda changes
- 13 2. **Health Order** ~ Town Health Officer Keith Ulrich presented a proposed Notice of Intent to Issue a Health  
14 Order for 393/411 Ferry Street for trash outside a mobile home with neighbors observing rats on the  
15 property. Motion by Roland to accept the Notice of Intent for 393/411 Ferry Street with the requirement  
16 to clean up the exterior grounds by August 20, 2018 at 3:00 p.m. Seconded by Dave. Voting: 4 in favor,  
17 0 against, motion passed. Susan asked if the town health officer could determine what is needed to  
18 inspect the inside of the mobile home (413 Ferry Street). Ron will review the legal requirements for health  
19 orders and inspections and report back to the Board.
- 20 3. **Mark French – Four 10-hour Days** ~ The Board discussed the highway department’s history of four 10-  
21 hour days plus 5 hours of shop work on Fridays at overtime resulting in a regular schedule of 45 hours  
22 per week and comparing that practice to a 40-hour week without scheduled overtime.
- 23 4. **Local 300 Proposed Highway Union Contract** ~ Motion by Roland to move into executive session to  
24 discuss the proposed employee union contract with the Town Administrator and Road Foreman attending  
25 at 9:15 a.m. Seconded by Roger B. Voting: 4 in favor, 0 against, motion passed. The Board came out of  
26 executive session. Mark French left the meeting at this point (10:05 a.m.)
- 27 5. **Maynard Zoning Enforcement** ~ The Board agreed that waiting for formal enforcement to begin was  
28 acceptable, if the two parties continue to work on the issue and keep the town informed.
