June 25, 2018 Monday, 5:30-7:00pm

Location: The Lanpher Memorial Library, upstairs

1. Update on Photo Op Board for events – George Cook will make the face-in-the-hole board. Sophie Clark will design/paint it with Donna Rasmussen as a backup if needed. It needs to be portable.
