Welcome - Agenda Review, Public Comment ~ No changes. No public comment. 16 17 2. FY2020 Budget – Review Draft – Ron handed out the 01/29/2019 draft with a 4.69% expense 18 budget increase. 19 a. Brad researched costs of new AEDs and found that the units cost about \$2,000 with 20 accessories. 10 existing units will be expiring soon with 5-year battery life and 8-year 21 warranty on the unit. Brad explained that there is one unit in North Hyde Park/Eden Fire 22 and the three trucks at the Town Fire Department. Brad noted that Morristown was just 23 certified as a HeartSafe community. Monthly CPR trainings for the public with AEDs 24 located in the community and emergency response vehicles are part of the certification 25 program. The Vermont EMS Office & VT Dept. of Health are the recognizing agency. 26 The older AEDs would be located at facilities until they are replaced, and the newer ones 27 would go to response vehicles. Motion by Dave to approve the AED program with two units to be purchased in FY2020 at a cost to not exceed \$2,100 per unit. Seconded by 28 29 Roger A. So voted. 30 b.
