Ice cream has been ordered. Ben & Jerry's will send us 5 2.4 gallon tubs. We will try to get 3 gallon tubs from Charlmont – probably vanilla and chocolate.

Dan and Judy are working on the announcement insert for the electric bill.

John will work on getting people to do sauces. Everett will let Nancy Webster know and give her a chocolate sauce recipe if he isn't able to make the chocolate sauce this year. He makes 5 batches.

5. **Hyde Park Home Day** – Co-chairs – Jenna Decker, Judy Clark, Deb Henderson. Saturday, September 21.

It was agreed we would hold a Home Day again this year. Jenna has some great ideas for getting more people involved as we're down in circle member help. We need to go over the benefits of being a sponsor. We don't have a tiered sponsorship but could move to this if it made sense. Gail Deuso had suggested this in the past.
