- **Scribe** – Deb Henderson & **Time Keeper** – Jack Anderson
- **Update on Dan Young** – Dan is doing better. He hopes to come home from the hospital tomorrow.
- **Financial Report** (Deb) – The checking account balance is **\$6,619.97**. **No monies have been spent since the last meeting.**
- **Jim Marvin Award** – (Judy) - HPCC received an honorable mention 2019 Marvin Award for long-term contributions to community service. John and Judy attended the awards ceremony. Judy brought the plaque to the meeting and we discussed places to hang it – library or Fork & Gavel. **Judy will ask Amy if we can hang it at the library.**
- **Jedediah Hyde Ice Cream Social Planning Update** (John) – **July 15 from 6 – 7:30 pm @ Governor’s Inn.**
  - a. John will put a FPF post tomorrow or Wednesday. Deb will do one on July 7 or 8<sup>th</sup>.
  - b. Mike Wickenden got **12 cookie makers**. John read the list of cookie makers. Kim Lambert, Ellen Gibbs, Kathy Geirsbach, Nancy Shambaugh, Susan Bartlett, Jane Fontane, Charlotte Williams & son, Sarrah McNalle, Martha Coleman, Debbie Wheeler and Mike Wickenden, Gina Jenkins and Schaaf Family.
  - c. **Parking** – any new ideas? – John will check with Suzanne for handicap parking.
  - d. Giselle Minor and Julie Rohleder will work the **setup table**. John is working on getting **ice cream scoopers** - Greg Paus and Deirdre Beaupre have agreed to be scoopers. Everett will do second shift toppings and scoop if needed.
  - e. **Guest book** – Place at the HPCC table (see below).
  - f. **Marketing** – Posters (Jenna) – Jenna drafted a couple. John will work with her to get corrections. Looking for volunteers to hang up throughout Hyde Park and North Hyde Park.
  - g. **Road signs** – Dan used to take care of these. Jack has 5 HPCC signs in their barn. John will check to see if these are for ice cream social or Home Day. Signs are to put on the side of the road to announce the social – date, time, location. Judy would like one in North Hyde Park and 2 in Hyde Park. We may need to buy some.

  - i. John is trying to find some young people for set up and clean up. He’s struck out so far.

- j. **Announcer** – Jonathan Henderson agreed to be the announcer.
- k. **Sauces** – Nancy is making the hot fudge sauce. Judy and John will make the strawberry sauce and butterscotch sauce. Anyone to make blueberry sauce and rhubarb sauce? Marilyn Zophar will get sprinkles, M&Ms and whipped cream. An order has been placed with Hannafords – they said they would donate these items. They have compostable bowls. Will there be electricity available? Nancy and perhaps others would like it to plug in crock pots with sauce.
- l. Will there be a **presence from the sheriff's office**? **Jack will look into and check to see if we can park behind the former gas station.**
- m. **Ice cream** – we have a confirmation that Ben & Jerrys will give us 4 tubs and we will buy 3 tubs. John will decide from whom we buy these extra tubs.
- n. **Photo Op Board** - Needs some reconstruction – can it be done in time or do we need to delay fixes until Home Day? – Judy reported 2 things need to be tweaked. The top hole is way too big. Maybe George could make it smaller or Donna could paint hair to fill in somehow. The other thing – one event is not correctly named on the board. Donna could probably fix it. Library will have a photo op also.
- o. **Children's Activities** – not having any this year – some children are too wild and unsupervised.

  - a. **Select Sub-Committee Chairs** – Jenna, Judy and Deb will co-chair Home Day. Susan Hayes will co-chair next year. Deb will do the database.
  - b. **Music** - Jenna – Jenna knows a group of women – what is their name? and a few young girls who have a band and would like to come. Jenna will look into both of these.
