

TOWN OF HYDE PARK
Parking Policy for the Vermont State Park-and-Ride
Effective January 1, 2011

1. The parking of any vehicle in the Vermont State Park-and-Ride lot shall be within lanes, and shall conform to any and all other directions posted on the site.
2. The Vermont State Park-and-Ride facility is free and open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. HOWEVER, annually from November 15th to April 15th, no vehicle may be parked at the Vermont State Park-and-Ride lot between the hours of midnight and 5:00am.
3. Parking in all areas shall be in such a manner as to provide ample room for ingress and egress from the area to all other vehicular traffic.
4. All persons utilizing the Vermont State Park-and-Ride lot during times of winter weather shall give due consideration to such hazards as ice, snow and slippery ground conditions. All persons shall comply with temporary directions, as may be occasioned by snow obstruction, snow removal or other winter conditions, or by maintenance or repair work.
5. Use of the Vermont State Park-and-Ride lot shall at all times be entirely at the risk of the owner or operator. The Town of Hyde Park does not at any time or under any condition assume any responsibility for damage to or theft of any privately owned vehicle in any state parking lot, or for personal injury, from any cause whatsoever, to any person or persons utilizing the Vermont State Park-and-Ride lot.
6. Please do not leave valuables in your vehicle. Vandalism and break-ins, though uncommon, can and do occur.
7. Overnight camping, abandoned vehicles and commercial enterprises are prohibited in the Vermont State Park-and-Ride lot.

Violations and Penalties

1. Any vehicle improperly parked, or in any other manner in violation of any part of these regulations, may be subject to removal forthwith. The Town of Hyde Park shall not be responsible for any costs or other expense occasioned by such removal.
2. Please help keep the Vermont State Park-and-Ride facility clean by not littering. There is a \$500.00 fine for littering.
