The Town of Hyde Park runs on volunteers with over 40 residents helping every town service - draft zoning rules for your property, elections, services at the library, planning major road projects. Volunteers are valuable and critical to effective government.

Committees usually meet monthly (now most offer a remote option) and current members will appreciate your time and contribution. All positions come with town-provided training, the assistance to get you started and support during your term. One term or many, please check out your area of interest on the town website, contacting current committee members or emailing admin@hydeparkvt.com.

- Planning Commission - drafting new zoning regulations, oversee pedestrian safety studies, work on town plan goals – four-year term
- Development Review Board - reviewing land development for impacts on neighbors, the environment and applying permit conditions to enforce zoning bylaw requirements
- Emergency Management – Deputy Director – work with town departments and regional sources to prepare the community for disaster response
- Town Energy Committee – discuss local actions for energy conservation and energy policy impacts on the environment: Lower-the Blade program, energy conservation matters - three-year terms
- Town Finance Committee – plan funding for capital projects, investment decisions & annual audit review; works with town staff and elected officials
- Recreation & Youth Sports Committee, Gihon Valley Hall Committee and Hyde Park Community Circle are always welcoming new members!!
